Job Title: SSP Regional Healing Catalyst, Haa Tóoch Lichéesh Coalition

Hours/Week: 40 hours per week

Salary/Wage/Benefits: \$60,000/DOE plus benefits

Position Description: This position is funded jointly by Sustainable Southeast Partnership (SSP) and Haa Tóoch Lichéesh Coalition (HTL). The Sustainable Southeast Partnership is a dynamic collective uniting diverse skills and perspectives to strengthen cultural, ecological, and economic resilience across Southeast Alaska. The person chosen for this role will work to support HTL Coalition and our community partners in our shared mission of preventing systemic violence and addressing widespread inter-generational trauma through culturally relevant and place-based programs which promote and facilitate equity and healing across communities.

Key Responsibilities:

- Oversee Collective Impact regional workgroups and collaborative projects to support regional healing opportunities, including overseeing regional Needs and Resource Assessment to inform the HTL Strategic Plan.
- Work with key partners to ensure culturally relevant and trauma informed programs that promote healing with a regional scope.
- Provide culturally relevant and place-based programs for Haa Tóoch Lichéesh Coalition member organizations and across the spectrum of services.
- Responsible for the oversight and reporting of grant responsibilities associated with programs.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- *Must pass a background check.*
- *3+ year experience in this or related field.*
- *Supervision experience.*
- *Lived experience within Alaska Native worldviews, cultures and communities is required.*
- *Must have or acquire CPR and First Aid Certification.*
- *COVID vaccination required (exemptions possible).*

- *Must have a thorough understanding of domestic violence, sexual assault and the needs of victims or the willingness to learn.*
- *Must have experience in community work that addresses equity, anti-oppression, violence prevention, and/or community organizing.*

- *Must support AWARE's Philosophy: A commitment to providing options and alternatives to victims of domestic violence and sexual assault.*
